Bev moves to approve as corrected adding in the bills paid, Kim seconds, all were in favor

Colin Macweeny presentation regarding impact fees. After it was found that we do not currently have any sizable subdivisions moving forward in our district, it was determined that there is not currently enough growth to support initiation of impact fees. We should re consider when growth exceeds 40-50 homes in one year.

Chairman/Commissioner Harvey Church: Winter water locations. Cost is estimated not to exceed \$2500.00 to complete the dry hydrant at Baldwin corner. Kim motioned that we approve this dry hydrant at Baldwin corner, Harvey 2nds and all were in favor. We will move ahead with that installation and then reassess additional locations. Allan Hermanson is working with Kirk Willie to draft a legal easement for his location. This will require a survey Harvey is getting a quote for that survey. Harvey could also provide rock for the approach. Holding Tanks in Montour were also discussed. They appear clean inside, further investigation in the future.

Would like new flashlights that are fire rated, this was tabled until January.

Nifers has a new updated program that we need to learn for making fire reports.
