**Commissioner Bev Martin:**

- Discussed getting a sniffer for Ola Station, also that Snap on makes a inexpensive thermal imaging devise, and Ridgid has one at Home Depot for something like \$120
- Is the old repeater in storage in Ola able to create more reception for the area, Jim will ask Vance
- Houston Grandpa wants to donate to the burnout fund, asked where to send, Poppy confirmed the Syringa Club.

**Fire Chief Jim Heikes:**

- Reported 1 fire call outs and 0 EMS call outs and no driveway inspections but 2 final letters went out.
- Sherriff is pulling repeater off of crown point, Long discussion regarding what to do. They will pull out May/June and we can lease to OCT with BLM no cost just paperwork. Speedy quick may be paying \$2500 per year to BLM, not confirmed. The gate access may be through the Bureau of reclamation. White cloud will do a coverage survey for a couple hundred bucks for Tri Pod, Snow Bank, Squaw Butte, Crown Point. Tracy will talk to the gun club about getting access through the road up there. Lease is also with Speedy quick, Frontier-Ziply and GCFD2. There is a relationship with the landowners and the sheriff that we may not have without them. have to go from Berk to Bean to Tracy for access. Need to research if there is a slot on snow bank # for state communications to discuss before installation of new repeater. Radar Dome at west mountain. BLM has a 4-5 acre land island at Crown Point.
- Cost of repeater was covered by insurance for all but \$1000 deductible.
- Door decals for trucks requested, conversation re magnets vs stickers. Tracy Motion to approve \$986.00 for decals Harvey 2nds. Allen Hermanson will order them.
- Jim Anderson truck needs to insured, transfer title/license, tank with water by 05/31/23 or sooner.

**Kevin Jillette:**

- Radios arrived 1 black and 8 orange they are being programmed, tested and handed out

**Mechanic Michael McCaulou:**

- Mailbox installed
- Kevin Hale picked up 10 gallons of oil and filters for 967 & 970
- Battery maintainer installed in 928 \* 905
- Jim had Mike order a radio and dash adapter for 951
- Hand Dreyer in Sweet has been installed
- Presented one additional bill and stating that another was not paid total around 200 board approved that it can go on the debit card if Poppy gets itemized receipts.
